We've got you covered . . .

We've had rain recently, which means golf can be affected. Fairgrounds tends to drain better than most courses in the area, so even if it's rained, we are often "playable," which means different things to different golfers.

The course may be soft and a little wet, but usually not muddy and the greens are usually "putt-able." Remember, no "rain checks" once you tee off.

Obviously, conditions are not always ideal but if you really want to get in 9 or 18 holes, we'd love to have you play. Call us and we'll let you know the situation. We'll always be honest and transparent and maybe save you a trip here.

We get a lot of calls asking "is the driving range open?", especially during rainy weather. With the exception of late Mondays (clean pick) and early Tuesday mornings (mowing the range), we are open just about all the time.

We don't always mow Tuesdays if the weather is bad or we have mower issues, so we urge golfers to call the Pro Shop (707-284-3520) and we'll let you know the status. Our range is unique in that it is not only covered, but it's lighted.

So while you can't hit balls at most area ranges when the it rains or when it's dark, that's not the case at Fairgrounds. We are open by 7 a.m. and don't close until about 8 p.m. (Mondays excepted).
