If you want to use our range . . .

It's that time of year when we are getting more rain. That being the case, we have had to hand-pick the driving range on some mornings when the ground is too soft or wet to allow us to take our ball-picking machine out the night before.

If we have to do a morning hand-pick, there is a chance we will not open the range until 8 a.m. Keep in mind that this is not *always* the case . . . even when it rains, we are sometimes able to pick the range at night. But we suggest you call us first.

We're usually in the Pro Shop by 6:30 a.m. – and we'll let you know the status of the driving range. Just call 707-284-3520.

We have also experienced frost delays recently. They usually last until 8:30 or so, but again, call us and we will let you know. Same goes for use of electric carts . . . our course superintendent **Jason Cavanaugh** makes that early morning decision.
